APPLICATION PROCESS:

To be considered, the following items must be submitted for review:

- 1. Complete application form
- An one-page biography -double spaced, Times New Roman, font size 12
- 3. An essay of "How I contribute to and care about my community." (No more than 600 words double spaced, Times New Roman, font size 12)
- 4. One letter of recommendation (from faculty, teacher, counselor, community leader, or supervisor).
- 5. A copy of the most recent official transcript.

Please send via first class mail (no registered or certified mail) by March 31 2014 the following package: completed application, biography, essay, letter of recommendation, and official transcripts.
